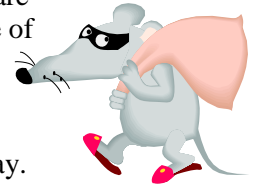

'Tis the Season for Safety Reminders

You can be a part of keeping crime low in our neighborhood during the upcoming holiday season. While you're focused on family, travel, or other holiday-related things, neighborhood thefts are typically on the rise during this time of year. Here are some safety tips:

- ☞ Let a trusted neighbor know if you are going to be out of town. Have them park in your driveway.
- ☞ Stop your paper and mail, or have a neighbor get it for you every day.
- ☞ If you are expecting a package, leave a message for the carrier to hold the package and you will pick it up, or come home at lunch and check for it, or have a neighbor get it off your porch. You could consider having it shipped to your work place.
- ☞ Hanging Holiday Lights? Check for frayed wires. Live tree? Water it often!
- ☞ If you have a security system, turn it on, and let the monitoring company also know you will be out of town.
- ☞ See an unknown person in your or your neighbors yard? Don't assume they belong there. Call 9-1-1 to report a suspicious person.
