What is National Night Out?

National Night Out (NNO) is an opportunity for communities nationwide to promote police-community partnerships, crime prevention, safety awareness and neighborhood camaraderie.

Why participate in NNO?

National Night Out is designed to:

- Heighten crime awareness, drug prevention and safety awareness
- Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime programs
- Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships
- Send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back
